



**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN
ST. MARIANNA UNIVERSITY SCHOOL OF MEDICINE, JAPAN
AND
FACULTY OF MEDICINE, KHON KAEN UNIVERSITY, THAILAND**



This Memorandum of Understanding is made by and between St. Marianna University School of Medicine, Kawasaki, Japan and the Faculty of Medicine, Khon Kaen University, Khon Kaen, Thailand for the cooperation and collaboration between two institutions.

1. Objective

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as "Understanding") relates to the exchange of students (bachelor's students) to complete a four-week Clinical Clerkship in the affiliated hospitals of the partner university.

2. Administration of the Exchange Program

The Exchange Program shall be administered with regard to admission, registration and assistance in visa application and finding accommodation by the International Offices of both partner universities.

3. Academic Supervision

The host university will appoint a qualified advisor and provide appropriate courses of study for each exchange student. Each student shall determine the clinical rotation departments at the host university in consultation with academic advisors of both home and host universities. Selected students shall possess sufficient language proficiency of English (approved by the home university).

4. Selection of Students

The students participating in the exchange program under the terms of this Understanding shall be selected by the home university. It is suggested that students are officially authorized to participate in the bed side learning of their home university before participating in the partner university's Clinical Clerkship. Selected students will follow the application/registration procedures of the host university.

5. Number of Students

Each year, up to two students may be enrolled at the partner University for the four-week Clinical Clerkship. However, the number of students may be modified by mutual consultation in advance.

6. Tuition and Administrative Fees

Tuitions and administrative fees will be waived for students participating in the exchange program on both sides.

7. Organizational Aspects

The host school's International Office will provide assistance concerning

- a) visa application documents
- b) application/registration procedures
- c) housing
- d) general information about the university and the city

8. Financial Responsibility

The host university shall be responsible for student's accommodation, and exchange students shall be responsible for their own expenses including travel expenses, living costs and health care fees.

9. Visiting of Faculty Members

Each institution may send its faculty members to conduct research or undergo medical training, or to make a scientific visit in its counterpart institution. The duration and scope of this activity will be determined by mutual consent of both institutions.

10. Duration and Amendment


This Understanding will be effective when the representatives of both universities affix their signatures to it. It shall stay in effect for five (5) years from the date of signing and renewal may be considered by mutual written consent of both institutions. It may be subject to revision or modification from time to time by mutual agreement. Such revision, once approved by both universities, will become part of this Understanding.

11. Termination

Either university reserves the right to suspend or terminate this Understanding upon six months' written notice to the other party. In this case, any student already approved to participate in this program by both parties shall be allowed to complete their program under the conditions of this Understanding.


