



## Memorandum of Understanding

between

## Queen Mary University of London and Khon Kaen University

This Memorandum is made and entered into this day between Queen Mary University of London and Khon Kaen University.

By means of the Memorandum, Queen Mary University of London and Khon Kaen University agree to seek to develop joint activities for the purpose of facilitating academic exchange and cooperation in the broad field of medicine and health science.

Other joint activities included in this Memorandum may in the future include:

- 1. Collaborative teaching
- 2. Collaborative research
- 3. Exchange of academic staff
- 4. Exchange of Research Fellows
- 5. Exchange of students
- 6. Exchange of publications
- 7. Visiting of academic staff
- 8. Visiting of Research Fellows and students

It is anticipated that specific activities will result from this Memorandum of Understanding and in this event both parties agree that these activities will be subject to separate legally binding agreements. Both parties understand that all financial arrangements will have to be negotiated and will depend on the availability of funds.

Any intellectual property rights owned/controlled by a party before the date of this MOU and during the term of this MOU will remain the property of that party. In the event that either party wishes to use the name and/or logo of the other party for purposes in relation to this MOU, the written consent of the other party shall be obtained in advance of such use.

This Memorandum becomes effective from the date of the signatures below and will be in existence for a period of 5 years, unless one party gives notice six months in advance that it wishes to amend or terminate the agreement.

For this purpose, the responsible parties will be the Vice Principal (International) of Queen Mary University of London and the President of Khon Kaen University.

The Memorandum places no financial or legal obligations on either of the parties, nor does it create any legal relationship between them.
