MD-KKU is now ranked in the top 350 in the QS World University Rankings by Subject 2015 for Life Sciences and Medicine.

The Faculty of Medicine at Khon Kaen University was established in 1972, the first medical school in Northeast Thailand. The Faculty has grown dramatically since its inception. Currently, one-third of the university's personnel work for the Faculty, including academic lecturers, doctors, nurses, medical technicians and support staff.
